To all my faithful partners, to all my faithful friends, to all my acquaintances to all my family, blessings upon each of you at this time.

Again we thank each of you that have supported us with your prayers, your phone calls, and with your generous offerings each month. May God's blessing accompany you each day. We need all of you to join in with those who are able to provide the much needed finances to accomplish more for the Kingdom.

This past few weeks have been dedicated to procuring a special visa in order for us to stay on in Brazil for at least another year, should that be possible. It will depend o many things. But after appealing to the Ministry of Foreign Relations for an extended authorization to stay on, we should by this coming Thursday or Friday we should know what our future should be. Thanks for your continued prayers.

Upon receiving our extended visa, we must procure our own house to live in. For the last six months, one of our pastors here has extended the entire bottom floor of his home for us to live in free of rent and financial encumbrances, this has been a real financial blessing! We thank pastor Gerald and his family for their hospitality!

This mean we will be moving out to a rental house, possibly for the remainder of our time here. Should some of you wish to contribute to monthly rent, indeed would be a tremendous blessing, for we did not by any means figure this in to our budget. Your monthly help is much appreciated! A more comfortable place for Renee is really needed also!

✧ Please find more photos of the church project which is coming to a close. We spend this entire day today, painting and finishing the roof and still lack a few more things to do on the roof in order to be done there. It is by far the most attractive building in the neighborhood and will be a grand blessing to this very poor congregation. We will have roughly 7 thousand dollars in this project, this alone is a miracle in what we have been able to accomplish with a small amount. We especially thank those who have made it possible!

The second church project is in the footer stages and is remove from us some four hours by car, I will however be visiting this city in the near future and will hope to have pictures soon to send you.

Visitors from the USA are a welcome blessing! We are looking still for Pastor Lynn Davis and James D. Baker this month sometime and then Pastors G.W. Ruiz, Denis Wiccus, they will be ministering in different areas.

✧ Possibly the greatest blessing of the mission field is our continual opportunity to do personal witnessing, these folks always seem to have the time to listen. Today I was able to speak with a young Baptist preacher and have been invited to preach in their congregation..amen! We will be looking for that opportunity soon!

✧ I was also ministering in a house meeting with about 50 folks and one young man came up and ask me if his pastor could call me and invite me to come to his church, I agreed, a few days later a trinitarian pentecostal minister called me and requested our visit. So in about two more weeks, we will entering in to that door the Lord willing!

There are more places to step into than we have the ability to attend. I still remain very close to my sweet bride due to her condition and this limit us somewhat, but the Lord is beginning to open more doors.

✧ The conference/seminar/ campgrounds project require your prayers. This is one of the most effective ways to evangelize and to train ministers and to make new contacts, please help us take this very special request to the throne of grace. May God bless you in this also!

I must travel tomorrow across this big city to minister to a local congregation, we are expecting the Holy Spirit to move on behalf of so many souls in need.
