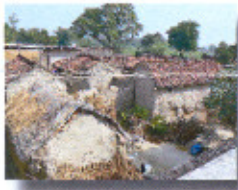


# Peace Mission of India & Nepal

Just to give you a glimpse of our evangelistic work area, to celebrate christmas with some of the most



unreached people, we drove 28 miles in a jeep, on a bumpy but paved road, crossing two rivers with about three feet of water each. Then we had to go off the paved road for about three miles on a gravel road, which progressively got worse. After that, we were on a mud road for about two miles before we had to give up as we got stuck in the mud. The village was another three miles and we had to leave our stuff (musical instru-

ments, some gifts and a load of New Testament to be distributed) as they walked to the village to bring a bullock cart which would take the last part of the journey. But all was worth to see the Power of the Gospel touching the lives in that unreached area.

By the grace of the Almighty I will be on an eight day Holy land tour (Feb.24 Mar.2) with a church group from Mesquite, TX. The church has provided all the funds to meet the expense. I have seen so many tombs and graves that are closed but I had a great desire, for a long time, to go see 'the Tomb' that is empty so I could tell the world that He is NOT there but is ALIVE!!
